

2012 Mid-Del Foundation Grants to Delaware Organizations



On November 19, 2012 at Harrington Casino, representatives from 35 Delaware organizations were awarded financial grants by the Mid-Del Charitable Foundation. The Foundation, developed to consolidate the charitable undertakings of The Delaware State Fair, Inc. and Harrington Raceway, Inc., supports Delaware-based organizations and charitable, educational, and scientific endeavors which address the wide range of issues, including: health and human services, the arts, agriculture, education, and the environment.

The Way Home is a volunteer project at the Sussex Correctional Institute whose mission is to free individuals from the cycle of crime and despair by providing them with the holistic support after prison that generates hope, self-sufficiency, and connection to the community.

Funds will be used to support a case manager position to meet demand for the services provided by The Way Home.
